- What is classroom security

STEP 2

Evaluate current policies and practices

- Key control
- Building access & time schedules
- Visitor policy
- Lockdown policy
- Commitment to security over conveniences

STFP 3

Assess existing openings to ensure current security is fully functional

- Assess each component of opening system
- Identification of lock function

STEP 4

Prepare plan to address security concerns

- Review action items identified during audit and present locking options
- Review existing security status against the desired level of security defined in step 1
- Evaluate integrity of master key system
